Interview Historic Preservation Board Candidate

The Board interviewed Karen J. Lloyd. Following the interview and discussion amongst the Board, Board member Brouillette moved to recommend Karen J. Lloyd be appointed to the regular member position, seconded by Board member Nimmer, motion passed unanimously.

Certificate of Appropriateness for the Lafayette Cemetery Perimeter Fence and Gate

Board member Nimmer announced that he needed to leave the meeting and moved to appoint a sub-committee consisting of Board member Schwendler, Dowling and Brouillette to review the Certificate of Appropriateness for the Cemetery fence and gate, seconded by Board member Brouillette. The motion passed unanimously.

Due to a lack of a guorum the Board meeting adjourned and the sub-committee meeting was called to order.

The sub-committee discussed how the cemetery was established in 1891 and how the city logo was not compatible with the sign but if it needs to be included it should be made from the same wrought iron material. The committee approved the fence and gate design for the cemetery subject to:

Option 1:

- a) Remove City Logo from the sign
- b) The sign arch shall state, "Lafayette Cemetery" using an appropriate font that closely replicates historic photo.
- c) Correct establish date to EST. 1891

Option 2 if City Logo must be included:

- a) The entire City of Lafayette Logo sign shall be made of the same wrought iron material as the rest of the sign.
- b) The sign arch shall state, "Cemetery" using an appropriate font that closely replicates historic photo.
- c) Correct establish date to EST. 1891
