#### Call to Order/Roll Call

On Friday, April 26, the Committee will co-sponsor a movie screening and information fair at Festival Plaza to raise awareness about climate change with Public Achievement students at Centaurus High School. On Saturday, April 27, the Committee will support service projects at Kid's Park Lafayette from 9:30-12:00 p.m. as part of Project YES' annual SeLebration, and later attend the Congressional District 2 Youth Summit in Boulder from 1:00-3:00 p.m.

The Committee reviewed the underage drinking video that it filmed with Officer Wendy Stogner in early March. In addition to creating a storyboard for the video project, members identified possible titles, background music, and graphics for the video, which will be unveiled at Centaurus High School and Peak to Peak Charter School on April 11.
