The monetary value of volunteer time in 2016 was \$ 23.56. \* The Independent Sector is a national, nonprofit organization that each year calculates the value of volunteer time based on current trends in the job market.

Last year they calculated \$23.56 as the national per hour worth of a volunteer's time.

If you deduct the 12% increase they include for fringe benefits, the wage is \$20.73 This is the wage amount used in the calculation for our volunteer program.
