A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, COLORADO, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE AND THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE REGARDING EMERGENCY SANITARY SEWER SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE'S NORTH END PHASE II SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette ("Lafayette") and City of Louisville ("Louisville"), collectively, the "Parties," are authorized by their respective Home Rule Charters and state statute to enter into agreements for the provision and sharing of services; and

WHEREAS, Louisville, has approved a development known as the North End Phase II Subdivision ("Project"), which includes the construction of a sanitary sewer lift station; and

WHEREAS, Lafayette, which is situated immediately adjacent to the Project, has existing waste water facilities which have the capacity to convey and treat sanitary sewer overflow discharges from the Project's sanitary sewer lift station; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire that the Project's sanitary sewer lift station include an emergency overflow connection to Lafayette's sanitary sewer collection system, and that the responsibilities, maintenance and costs of such connection and its operation be set forth in an agreement between the Parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lafayette, Colorado as follows:

The Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Lafayette and the City of Louisville for emergency sanitary sewer services for the City of Louisville's North End Phase II Subdivision is approved in substantially the same form as the copy attached hereto and made a part of this resolution and the Mayor is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.
