RESOLUTION No. 2013-17

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, COLORADO, GRANTING A NEW RETAIL LIQUOR LICENSE TO T3 GAS & FOOD MART d/b/a BAS ELINE'S T3 LIQUOR

WHEREAS, the City has received an application for a new Retail Liquor License, on March 6, 2013, and said application was verified complete; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has paid the required application and license fees and filed for a concurrent review with the Colorado Liquor Enforcement Division; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette City Council, sitting as the Local Licensing Authority, considered the new application on April 16, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Lafayette finds as follows:

- 1. The applicant is entitled to possession of the premises for which application is made under a lease agreement between Tenzin Khunkhen (landlord) and T3 Gas & Food Mart (tenant), the term of which expires on September 1, 2015.
- 2. The applicant has filed a floor plan for a portion of the interior gas station area. The Council approved said floor plan without exceptions.
- 3. The sale of liquor for consumption off the premises is permitted at the location for which the license is sought under the applicable zoning ordinances of the City of Lafayette.
- 4. The parties shown by the application as having a financial interest in the business for which the license is requested is Michal Krasilinec.
- 5. The Lafayette Police Department has conducted a preliminary background check of Michal Krasilinec and found no disqualifying information. Criminal history investigations are underway at CBI and FBI to determine whether the applicants' character and reputation are satisfactory to the Local Authority and therefore qualified to hold a liquor license.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lafayette, Colorado, as follows:

- 1. The application from T3 Gas & Food Mart d/b/a Baseline's T3 Liquor is hereby approved subject to the following conditions:
 - a.) Final clearance from FBI and CBI, which will be reported to the City Clerk through the Lafayette Police Department;

- b.) Approval of the Retail Liquor License by the State Licensing Authority; and
- c.) Approved final inspection of new construction by the Lafayette Building Official.
- 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval by the City Council.
