Minutes

Minutes

Public Comment

Todd Bernhart expressed an interest in WRAC due to his passion in recycling and composting. Sandy Buckland also was in attendance but did not speak.

WRAC Board Alternate Application

Applicant Maryanne Rose could not be in attendance due to a previous commitment and will be attending the November meeting.

Food Waste

Becky reported her ride-along with Dan Greeley from Sister Carmen on their non-prepared food pick-up for the SC food bank. Becky relayed her experiences with Starbucks and Chipotle and that caterers have generally not been receptive to food recovery efforts. Kali talked about Campus Kitchen that repurposes prepared food.

2018 Budget

There is \$450 remaining in the budget. Matt talked about the dog poop collection grant that he is applying for through Boulder County. He was wondering if WRAC would contribute towards this program as in-kind funding. With a motion by Adam and a second by Krystal there was a unanimous vote to allocate \$200 towards Matt's project.

Art Night Out Review

Overall, great results from ANO as their first zero-waste efforts. September had a 91% diversion rate and all five events together had an 89% diversion rate. Over 1300 pounds of material was either recycled or turned into compost.

Movie Series

Adam discussed the movie series, ideas for selected movies, times, location, food trucks, etc. with the Board. Matt is working on a poster to announce this series and the Art Hub can be of assistance, if we wish. Board discussed marketing strategies for the movie series.

RCAB/City Council Update

There was no update.

Old/New Business:

Matt mentioned that his HOA will be sending out a survey to its property owners about determining need for composting. Doug mentioned the September electronics recycling event

but did not have information of the weight recycled. Doug also mentioned that he will not be at the November meeting and will need someone to take minutes. Rebecca volunteered.
