Lynda.com is a premium online learning site with over 6,000 courses delivered by expert instructors, covering topics like business, web design, multimedia skills, software programs and much more. Users can earn certificates and upload them to LinkedIn (tip: use the same email to create your Lynda.com account). The site is free to Lafayette Public Library users.
