

Lafayette Historic Building Improvement Grants

Since 2014, the Lafayette Historic Preservation Board has offered grants to help defray the cost of maintenance, repairs, and restoration of historic buildings. These grants have varied from \$500 to \$2000 for 2019. To be eligible, buildings must be at least 50 years old and within Lafayette city limits, and improvement projects must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Help extend the life of the building.
- Keep historic materials to the extent possible, and if not, use identical or similar materials.
- Remove non-historic features or materials to expose historic ones.

Projects can be structural or cosmetic. Commercial buildings, houses, and outbuildings are eligible. Examples include, but are not limited to, foundation repair, window or door repair, weather sealing, painting, chimney repair, gutters, roof repair/replacement, reconstruction of historical architectural features, restoration using historical materials. All necessary building permits must be obtained. Projects that use Lafayette-based contractors, or DIY, are preferred.
